The undersigned, citizens of the State of Kansas, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a private banking corporation under the laws of the State of Kansas, and do hereby certify:

FIRST.

That the name of this corporation shall be THE

Midland Bank

SECOND.

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are to carry on the business of receiving money on deposit and to allow interest thereon, giving to the person depositing credit therefor; and of buying and selling exchange, gold, silver, coin, bullion, uncurrent money, bonds of the United States, of the State of Kansas, and of the city, county and school district in which any association shall be organized; of loaning money on real estate and personal security, at a rate of interest not to exceed the legal rate allowed to banks; and of discounting negotiable notes and notes not negotiable.
