All that part of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section number Twenty-six (26) Township Number Twenty-six (26) south of Range Number Twenty-five (25) west, lying east of the West line of the Ft. Dodge Military Reservation and south of the south line of the Dodge City and Ft. Dodge public road; containing $2\frac{1}{2}$ acres more or less.

Also Beginning at the north east corner of section Thirty-five in aforesaid Township and Range; thence south on section line to north bank of the Arkansas River, thence westerly along north bank of said river to the intersecting of the east line of Lot One (1) Water Street produced, thence northerly on said produced line to the intersection of the section line between sections 26 and 35; thence east on said section line to place of beginning

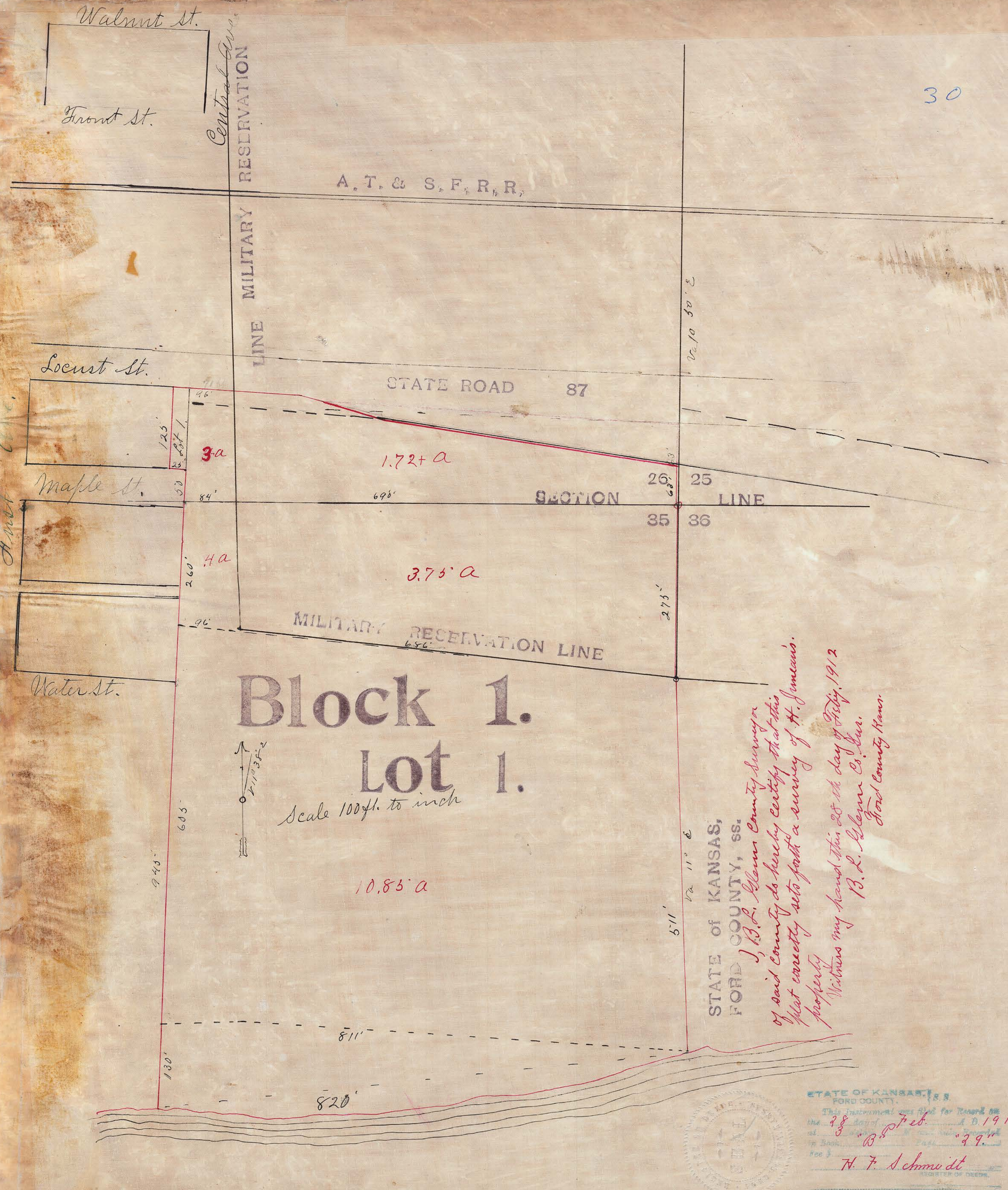
