OF

The undersigned, citizens of the State of Kansas, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a banking corporation under the laws of the State of Kansas, and do hereby certify:

FIRST.

That the name of this corporation shall be THE

" K A N S A S S T A T E B A N K "

SECOND.

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are to carry on the business of receiving money on deposit and to allow interest thereon, giving to the person depositing credit therefor; and of buying and selling exchange, gold, silver, foreign coin, bullion, uncurrent money, bonds of the United States and of the State of Kansas, and bonds and warrants of cities, counties, and school districts in the State of Kansas; of loaning money on real estate, chattel and personal security, at a rate of interest not to exceed the legal rate allowed by law; of discounting negotiable notes, and notes not negotiable, and to own a suitable building, furniture and fixtures for the transaction of its business, of the value not to exceed one-third of the capital of such bank.

THIRD.

That the place where its business is to be transacted is at

D O D G E C I T Y , K A N S A S .

FOURTH.

That the term for which this corporation is to exist is 50 *Years*

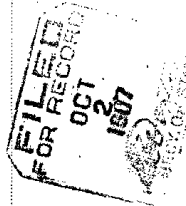
